



BEFORE

All required role reps (estimator, non-structural, structural and refinish technicians) must achieve at least **PROLEVEL 1** and progress annually.

All shops regardless of size require only **ONE ROLE REP PER ROLE** to achieve and maintain Platinum.

All non-role reps complete six credit hours of **ROLE-RELEVANT TRAINING.**

A single individual can represent all **FOUR** role rep positions.

Gold Class shops and Platinum technicians who are active by October 1, 2019 will qualify for a two-year transition plan. See pages 13-15 for details.

AFTER

All required role reps (estimator, non-structural, structural and refinish technicians) must achieve **PROLEVEL 2** and progress annually.

Role rep requirements are **SCALED TO SHOP SIZE** – 100% of structural technicians and 50% of estimators, non-structural and refinish technicians must achieve and maintain enhanced requirements. A minimum of one person must be declared in each role.

Annual training consisting of six role-relevant **VEHICLE AND TECHNOLOGY SPECIFIC TRAINING™** courses required for ProLevel 3 technicians and non-role reps.

No single individual may represent more than **TWO** role rep positions.

Two **HANDS-ON SKILLS DEVELOPMENT™** courses required each year.

ELECTRICAL/DIAGNOSTICS AND MECHANICAL THEORY COURSESmust be completed at the shop level.

Technicians achieve Platinum at **PROLEVEL 3.**
