Plastic Repair Workstation - Instructions for Use

Polyvance's 6075 Bumper Mate 2 Plastic Repair Workstation is designed to secure plastic bumpers, headlights, fenders, and other plastic parts in nearly any position while you repair the damage.

These instructions will give you some ideas about how bumpers and headlights can be held securely with the Bumper Mate 2. However, use your creativity and you will be able to discover other uses for this adaptable work surface.

Set Up:

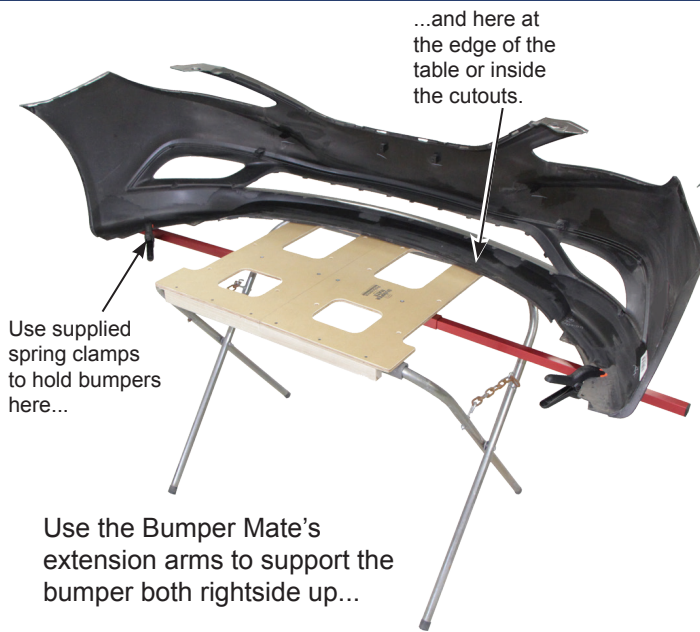


1. Open table upside down, loosen the locknut on the backside, then slide the bolt across the hinge line. Tighten the locknut to secure table in flat, open position.



2. Place the table on top of a folding work stand (not included) as shown. Insert the extension arms into the frame on the bottom of the table to support bumper ends.

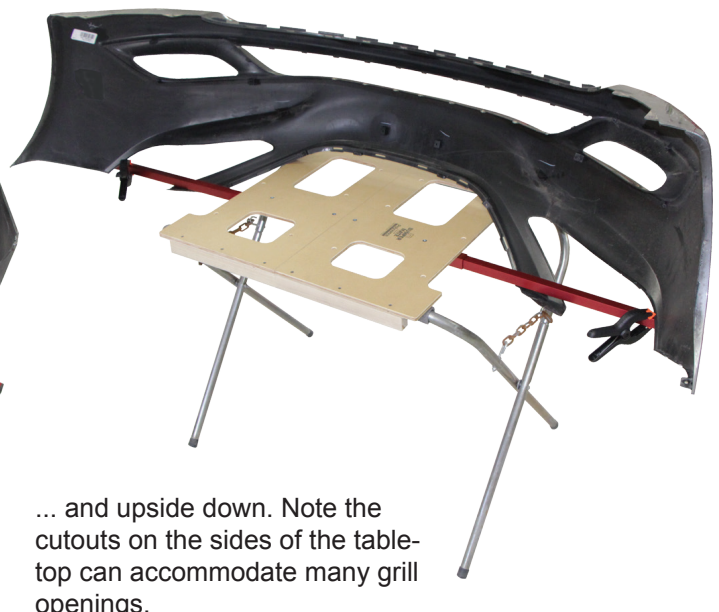
Ideas for Use:



Use supplied spring clamps to hold bumpers here...

...and here at the edge of the table or inside the cutouts.

Use the Bumper Mate's extension arms to support the bumper both rightside up...



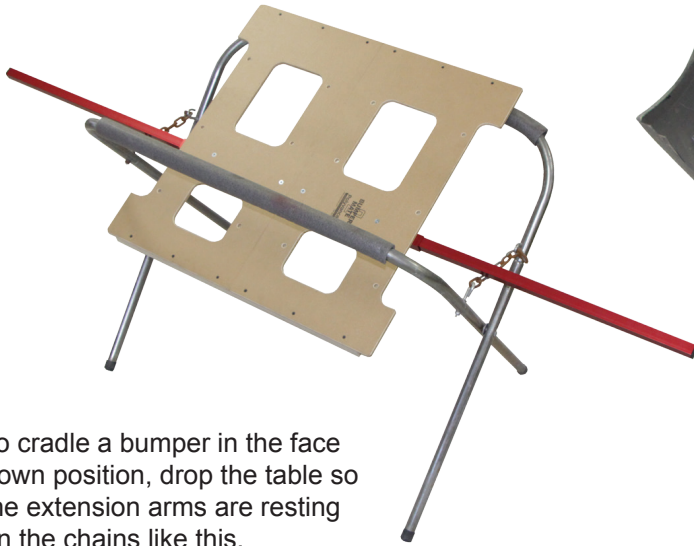
... and upside down. Note the cutouts on the sides of the table-top can accommodate many grill openings.

Ideas for Use:

The bumper face down can be stabilized using bungee cords to strap it to the table. See www.youtube.com/polyvance for our video instructions.



To cradle a bumper in the face down position, drop the table so the extension arms are resting on the chains like this.



To hold a bumper face up, remove the extension arms as shown.



Headlights and other odd-shaped parts can be strapped to the tabletop with bungee cords. Use the cutouts to stabilize the part before strapping it down.
